The **Quartermaster** keeps track of [troop](#) or [team](#) equipment and sees that it is in good working order. He keeps records on patrol/troop or squad/team equipment, makes sure equipment is in good working condition, and issues equipment and makes sure it is returned in good condition.

[Team Captain](#) in a Varsity Scout team.

Responsibilities

Keeps records on [patrol/troop](#) or [squad/team](#) equipment.

Makes sure equipment is in good working condition.

Issues equipment and makes sure it is returned in good condition.

Makes suggestions for new or replacement items.

Works with the troop committee member responsible for equipment.

Sets a good example.

Enthusiastically and [correctly wears the Scout uniform](#) (all four parts).
